Composite (White) Filling Policy:

As your dentist, I want to provide you with what I consider to be the best possible treatment for your child. For the majority of the fillings we do, a composite filling is more appropriate. Composite fillings (white fillings) require less preparation or removal of tooth structure. This can sometimes mean that no anesthesia is necessary. Removal of less tooth structure can also decrease the likelihood of a pulp or nerve exposure in some cases. Composite fillings bond to the tooth which greatly reduces the possibility of a future fracture of the tooth.

Your insurance plan is not likely to pay for a Composite (white) filling. You are expected to pay the difference between an amalgam (silver filling) and a composite filling on the day the service is rendered. The estimated difference is from \$35-\$45 per filling, depending on your insurance coverage.

Let me assure you that only services necessary and appropriate for your child's treatment and care will be performed. If you have any questions, someone in our office will be happy to assist you. Thank you for your understanding.
